New equipment, sponsored by Councillor Julie Morris and paid for out of the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL), has now been installed in the **Alexandra Rec playground**.

CIL is a charge on new developments to enable local authorities to deliver needed infrastructure.

CIL money also paid for the resurfacing of **Rifle Butt's Alley** and bought the **CCTV equipment** in Alex Rec, both championed by your Lib Dem councillors after suggestions from residents.

We will again be asking you what you would like this money to be spent on in future years.
